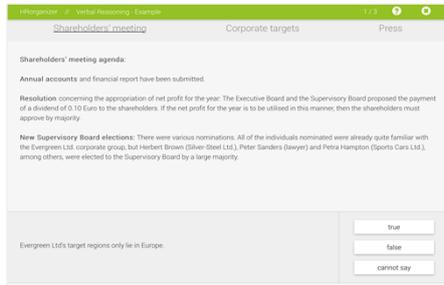

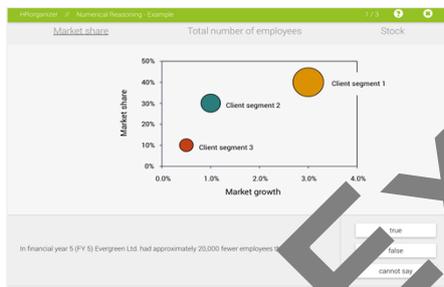
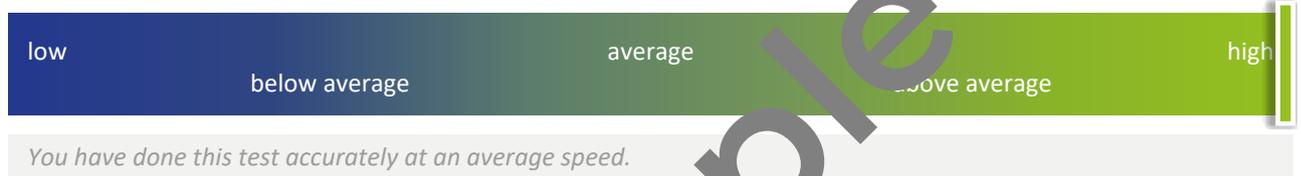
What am I capable of?

You have done several ability tests. Below you will find your results for each test to give you insight into your specific abilities.



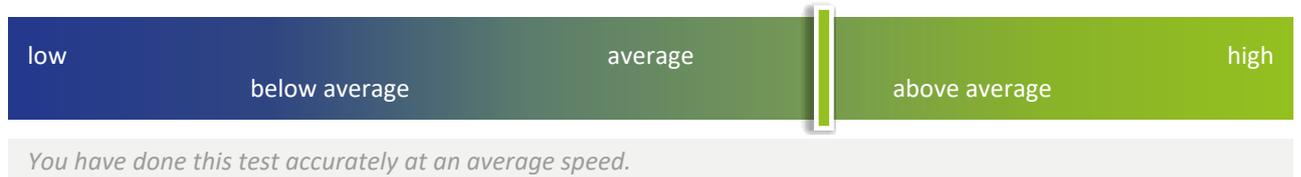
Verbal reasoning (t1)

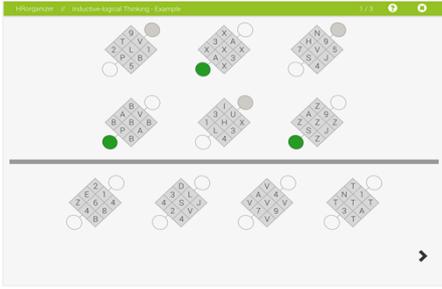
Numerical reasoning (t2)

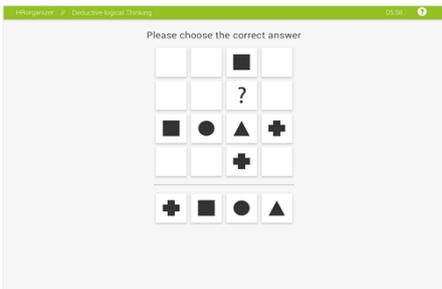

Discover rules and interrelations (t3)
